Remarks: Senior homonym of *Odontocyathus* Brook, 1893 (=Acropora)

Classification

Family: Caryophylliidae Dana, 1846

Genus: *Stephanocyathus* Seguenza, 1864, p. 61

Type Species

Platyrochus coronatus Pourtalès, 1867, p. 114 (no fig.) by Monotypy.

Holotype: MCZ 2769 (Unknown: Not Traced).

Type Locality: Recent: off Florida, 841 m

Remarks: Type species redescribed by Cairns (1979).

Diagnosis

Differs from the nominate subgenus by having 12-18 short costal spines or tubercles (C1-2) that sometimes fuse into a continuous basal rim.
